


Figure 1: Anti-luce bracket

1.1 Tools required to fit Canopy Table kit:

TOOL	PURPOSE	
Allen Key	Fastening various bolts	
13mm spanner	Spanner to tighten various bolts	
Drill	Drilling hole for R-clip wire rivet	
4.8mm drill bit	Drilling hole for R-clip wire	
Rivet gun	Riveting R-clip wire to canopy	

1. Fitting the Canopy Table kit

Step 1: Fitting the table brackets

Fit the table brackets to the aluminium nut slot extrusion as shown below. The distance between the internal faces of the brackets should be approximately 765mm to allow the table to slide into the brackets.





Figure 4: Table Bracket Assembled






Figure 6: Distance between table brackets

Fit the anti-luce bracket as shown in the diagram below.




Figure 7: Anti-luce bracket assembly
