Mozzie / Midgie Net to **Canopy** Camper

(CC-A-MN / CC-A-MN-SK)

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Review all instructions information carefully before installation.

1. Mozzie / Midgie Net Fitment – Tools, Fasteners & Materials

The tables below show the equipment required to start the fitment to either a Double Cab, or Xtra Cab, Canopy Camper.

* 3M PA-1 Hand Applicator:

This tool ensures that even pressure is applied when seating the self-adhesive Velcro, and aids in effective curing of the adhesive glue.

Alternative tools, or methods can be used, but it is highly advised to use this tool, or similar, to achieve the best results.

2. Surface Preparation




Figure 1: Cleaning / Priming Surface Indication, around Side Window.

2.1 Cleaning: The surfaces that need to be cleaned with the 50/50 mixture of Isopropyl Alcohol and water are indicated in Figure 1, below. Use a clean cloth/rag to gently wipe the indicated surfaces with the cleaning mixture. Allow enough time for evaporation. (The surfaces should be bone dry before progressing to the next step.)

2.2 Priming: This step is highly recommended for optimal results. Use a new, clean cloth/rag to lightly wipe the same indicated surfaces with 3M Tape Primer 94. Allow the primer to 'flash off'. (The surfaces should be bone dry before progressing to the next step.)

3. Velcro Application

3.1 Top Overhang - 50 mm Velcro Application:

Use a Measuring Tape to to confirm the overall length of the window overhang - 1.4 m nominal. Also note the position of the wire, feeding into the swivel light, referenced from the front overhang edge. Use scissors to cut a length of 50 mm Velcro, to the validated length, as well as making a width-ways cut, at the wire location measurement, just long enough to allow flexibility around the wire.




Figure 2: Velcro Application (50 mm)

Peel back the white backing layer, and apply the Velcro, starting in the one corner, flush on both edges and work your way along the length slowly. After the Velcro is seated, use the 3M PA-1 Applicator to apply a smooth, constant pressure sweep from one end to the other. This even pressure activates the bonding adhesive, and pushes out air bubbles. See Figure 2, below:

3.2 Sides & Bottom - 25 mm Velcro Application:

Use a Measuring Tape to to confirm the overall length of the vertical window rebate flange (both sides) - 592 mm nominal. Use scissors to cut two (2) lengths of 25 mm Velcro, to the validated length.

Use a Measuring Tape to to confirm the three (3) lengths between the striker plates, on the bottom rebate surface - 175 | 886 | 175 nominal. Use scissors to cut three (3) lengths of 25 mm Velcro, to the validated lengths.




Figure 3: Velcro Application (25 mm)

Peel back the white backing layer, and apply the Velcro, starting in the one corner, flush on both edges and work your way along the length slowly. After the Velcro is seated, use the 3M PA-1 Applicator to apply a smooth, constant pressure sweep from one end to the other. This even pressure activates the bonding adhesive, and pushes out air bubbles. See Figure 3, below:

4. Mozzie / Midgie Net Fitment



Allow 24 hours cure time for the Self-Adhesive Velcro, before attaching the Mozzie / Midgie Net.

Simply line up, and attach the Mozzie / Midgie Nets, so that they look like Figure 4, below:
