

FITMENT INSTRUCTIONS

CANOPY CUPBOARD



Preliminary information

Installation and fitment instructions includes the tools required, fasteners included in the kit, and the hardware included in the kit.

Please follow the instructions and check installation steps with the images in this document.

Alu-Cab recommends that all sealing work is allowed to cure for 24 hours, after which you may drive the vehicle on normal paved roads. Before driving off-road with your Alu-Cab product or operating your roof conversion, an additional cure period of 48 hours is required.

Failure to follow these instructions will void your warranty. Please ensure that you follow the sealant manufacturers curing time as per their technical data sheet.

These times may differ slightly from the times we have recommended.
















Assembled Canopy Cupboard



Fit the 3 off bottom brackets to the canopy nut slot frame using the supplied M8x20 bolts, nylock nuts and washer fasteners. Slide the M8x20 bolts into the nut slot frame of the canopy (2 per mounting bracket).








Leave the nuts only finger tight as it may be necessary to shift them later.

Install the three supplied bottom mount brackets so that they are equally spaced along the length of the canopy cupboard.

The next step is to slide the canopy cupboard in through the rear door opening on the canopy and rest it on top of the bottom brackets. Have someone hold the cupboard in place and ensure that it is spaced so that the gap between the front rebate and rear rebate is the same



With the cupboard in the correct position note which nut slots in the roof align with the top mount bracket of the cupboard. Slide 2 off M8x35 hex head bolts into the nut slots off the roof. Fit the top mount bracket.



Choose Correct Nut Slots With the Top Bracket fitted use three M6x20 Button Head bolts to fasten the Top Bracket to the Cupboard. The Bracket is height adjustable to suit multiple canopies. Remember to fit plastic nut caps over the nylock nuts






Photo of Assembled top bracket



With the Top Bracket fitted you can adjust the bottom brackets. Ensure that they line up with slot cut outs on the canopy cupboard, and do not clash with the canopy mounting brackets.

With the bottom brackets in the correct position fully tighten the nylock nuts that were left finger tight. Slide the supplied M8 Cup square bolts into the canopy Cupboard, tying the bottom mount brackets to the canopy cupboards. Fasten the cupboard to the mount brackets using the supplied M8 nylock nuts, washers.

Add nut caps to any exposed bolt heads or nuts and your installation is completed!
