Preliminary information

Please follow the instructions and check the stability of the equipment before use.





User guide

Thread the ladder fitting through the holes in the tent bracket and turn the anti-luce to the lock position



Anti-luce unlocked position



Anti-luce locked position



User Guide — Extending the ladder:



Slowly pull the ladder out making sure that each run clicks / locks into place



The ladder runs must be evenly spaced from the tent bracket to the feet, all locked in place



Ensure that the weight is bore by the feet of the ladder and not hanging off the tent bracket.

The ladder runs/steps must ideally be parallel with the ground.



User Guide — Extending the ladder:









Ladder must not be overextended in length. Ladder steps must be parallel to the ground



User Guide

Collapsing the ladder for starage:



Unlock the Anti Luce and remove the ladder from the tent bracket.



Press the ladder quick release buttons from the lower steps to collapse the ladder.



Quick release button

NOTE: Ensure that the users' hands and fingers are on the side of the ladder when the runs are collapsing




Place the ladder extension against the ladder bracket








Be sure to place the extension to fit in between the bolts holding the bracket to the tent. Then slide the extension to the right so the pins move into the holes and move the antiluce to the lock position.

NOTE: Remove plastic nut-cap from the bracket attached to the ladder Repeat the same actions as before to mount the ladder to the extension
